The Preparatory Course for Secondary (PCS) is a course for non-native English speakers entering Year 6&7 (Ages 11-14); The curriculum is developed by the Curriculum Committee and based on the MYP (Middle Years Programme) of the International Baccalaureate (IB) (International Baccalaureate Organization, 2009). The course is offered in 20-week sessions and intended for students with a range of English language skills (from Beginner to Proficient Speaking). Teachers will be expected to tailor the course to meet the needs of their students (and their own).
